540-, 543-, 544-, AND 545-TYPE TELEPHONE SETS

1. GENERAL

- 1.01 This section provides identification and Fornstallation information for the 540B (MD), 543DBR 543DBC, \$543DBM (modular), \$544A (MD), 544B (MD), and 545B (MD) key telephone sets.
- 1.02 This section is reissued to:
 - Add the 543DBM (modular) key telephone set, Fig. 5
 - · Add Table B
- 1.03 Code numbers such as 544BAR/BBR cover manual and dial versions, respectively, of the same type telephone set.

2. IDENTIFICTION




Fig. 2-\$540-Type Telephone Set, Interior

- 2.01 The 540-, 544-, and 545-type telephone sets (Fig. 1 and 2) are desk-type, 4-button key telephone sets intended for use in 1A, 1A1, or 1A2 key telephone systems. The 543-type is intended for use with 761A hotel-motel PBX.
- 2.02 The 543DBC telephone set is not furnished from the factory but may be obtained by conversion of the 544BB and 545BB telephone sets which are modified at the distributing house to the equivalent of the 543DB telephone set (Fig. 3).
 ▶Optional conversions to and from the 543DBM telephone set are shown in Fig. 5.

INSTALLATION

Keys

3.01 The 588D 4-button key has a hold and three pickup buttons. The last one on the right may be converted to signaling by removing the \$\\$811218924\$ (P-12A892) screw detail and making the necessary wiring changes.



Fig. 1-\$540-Type Telephone Set\$

- 3.02 The button and collar assembly (Fig. 2) rests on top of the key plungers and is held in place by the housing through which the buttons protrude. A collar on the buttons serves to direct the light from the lamps to the plastic buttons.
- 3.03 The 588-type key is fastened to the base assembly by three screws. The 51A lamps are held in place by clip contacts on the lamp strip. The lamp strip itself is a separate assembly fastened to the key with two screws.
- 3.04 The 641A key is equipped with a lamp in the hold key position for message waiting feature. It is blocked inoperative. The line keys are nonlocking.
- 3.05 This arrangement allows the hotel or motel guest access to the PBX operator, local central office trunk line, or the toll operator.







Fig. 4—♦811218585 (P-12A858) Blocking Ring, Installed♦

- An unused button can be blocked by installing an \$811218585 (P-12A858) blocking ring (Fig. 4).

Exclusion Switch

3.07 The 543DB, 543DBM, and 545B telephone set are equipped with exclusion switches for remote answering arrangement.

Window Strip and Designation Cards

- 3.08 The removable window strip is held in place by two spring clips which fit into mating holes in the set housing and which also retain the designation card in place above the buttons.
- 3.09 A designation card, form E-4227, printed in 6-button size is used with the 540-, 544-, and 545-type sets and must be trimmed to fit the 4-button window strip assembly. The 543-type set is furnished with an ▶812758837 (P-27E883) form.

Optional Buzzer

3.10 A 7-type buzzer and 152A capacitor may be mounted on these sets by using a 44B bracket. The KS-20419L1 buzzer may be mounted in any convenient location such as the dial mounting bracket. These parts must be ordered separately.
