REFERENCE

503B, C AND 513B TELEPHONE SETS

1. GENERAL

1.01 This section is reissued to revise Fig. 3.

2. IDENTIFICATION

- 2.01 These common battery sets are used in conjunction with other equipment to provide DATA-PHONE® service.
- 2.02 With the exclusion key operated, the 503B telephone set can be used with the J1D402B data set to provide data service. With the exclusion key unoperated the set provides regular telephone service.
- 2.03 The 503C telephone set is used in Data Access Arrangements (DAA) where customer-owned equipment is connected to the DDD network through a coupler. Operation of the exclusion key places the DAA in the data mode and bridges the set receiver across the line to permit monitoring of line signals while in the data mode. This set can be also used to provide regular telephone service.
- 2.04 The mounting cord of the 513B telephone set plugs directly into the J1D401F data set. Operation of the exclusion key performs functions similar to the 503B telephone set. An additional turn-pushbutton key and lamp are furnished for test purposes.
- **2.05** For application of these sets, refer to Division 590.





Fig. 1-503B, C, or 513B Telephone Set



Fig. 3-\$503C Telephone Set, Connections




Fig. 4—513B Telephone Set, Connections

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
