COIN STATION SETS

LOCAL BATTERY — SELECTION

1.00 INTRODUCTION

This section covers, in table form, the selection of various types of coin collectors and associated subscriber sets for use on local battery lines employing initial 10-cent operation. Both prepay and postpay types are included.

2.00 GENERAL

- 2.01 The following tables are included in this section.
 - Table A—Selection of Dial Prepay Local Battery Coin Collector Sets
 - Table B—Selection of Manual Prepay Local Battery Coin Collector Sets
 - Table C—Selection of Dial Postpay Local Battery Coin Collector Sets

- 2.02 The general information in the tables contains the:
 - Types of dials to be used with these sets.
 - Types of handsets or transmitters and receivers which are recommended, as well as the types which may be substituted.

- Types of subscriber sets which may be used with each coin collector.
- Types of coin collectors which require rewiring to be used for local battery service.
- 2.03 When washer rejector and pull bucket return chute features are required, 197-type coin collectors may be arranged in the field for local battery talking per the circuit diagrams in the section entitled Coin Collectors, Prepay, 191CL, DL, GL, and HL, Local Battery Connections.
- 2.04 When the washer rejector feature of the 198-type coin collector is required, it may be arranged for local battery talking per the circuit diagram in the section entitled Coin Collectors, Postpay, 193GL and HL, Community Dial Office Service, Local Battery Connections.
- 2.05 Coin collectors are not selected by class of service, as it is assumed that they will be used on individual lines as recommended.
- 2.06 The selection of coin collector equipment is governed by requirements contained in the section entitled Transmission Zoning. The same color designations have been used in the table to designate recommended or reasonable substitute equipment.
