

2.00 When can 2-type key equipment be used?

These receivers may be installed as additional equipment when the customer desires a listening-in feature. A service order is required for these installations.

3.00 Where is it installed?

Installation may be made on all telephone sets except coin collectors.

4.00 How is it installed?

Connections are covered in the C Section entitled 2A and 2B Key Equipments, Connections.

• A 37-type varistor is required to reduce acoustical disturbances in the receiver with induction coil type telephone and subscriber sets.
