### 1.00 INTRODUCTION

This section covers the combination of apparatus, circuit diagram, and connections, for the 685B type of subscriber set when associated with coin collector sets for common battery service.

### 2.00 <br> GENERAL

The 685B subscriber set provides the characteristics of a 500 series telephone set, and in addition is equipped with an auxiliary relay that may be connected with coin collector sets for use where the loop resistance or ground potential causes faulty coin relay operation.
