2. IDENTIFICATION

2.01 Apparatus blanks are used to cover:

● Opening in nondial telephone.

● Openings in booths, shelves, and plates.

● Unequipped key spaces of 598-, 599-, 656-, 657-, and 635-keys.

2.02 Apparatus blanks for telephones are available in the same colors as telephone sets. Add proper color code when ordering blanks.

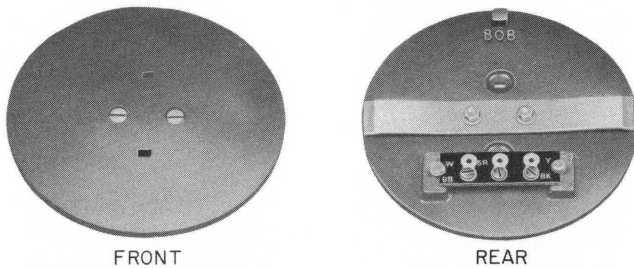


Fig. 1—80B—Gray finished disc, 4-15/32 inches in diameter equipped with number card holder group and provided with connecting terminals. For 300- and 325-type outdoor telephone sets.

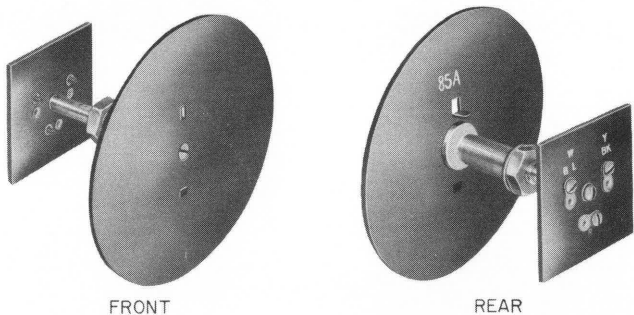


Fig. 2—85A—Black finished metal disc, 4-15/32 inches in diameter, equipped with number card holder group and connecting terminals. For 320-type explosion-proof telephone sets.
