1. GENERAL

1.001 This addendum supplements AT&T Practice 231-390-243, Issue 1. Place it ahead of Page 1 of the practice.

1.002 This addendum is issued to update AMA (automatic message accounting) information.

2. CHANGES TO PRACTICE

2.001 On Page 10, change paragraphs 5.02 through 5.04 to read as follows:

5.02 The AMA records for BCLID can be written on a usage-sensitive basis. These records include the quantify of DNs sent to the customer and/or the

number of private and unavailable DNs. Hourly AMA records can be written in the terminating office for each BCLID customer with the usage-sensitive capability. The following data is included on the sensitive AMA records for each I/O channel:

(a) Billing DN

(b) The number of listed DNs sent to a channel

(c) The number of DNs unavailable plus the DNs that are private.

5.03 Alternately, the customer could be charged a flat-rate for occupying a BCLID I/O channel. No hourly AMA records are written for BCLID customers with flat-rate billing.
