KEY SERVICE UNITS

300, 301, 302, 310, AND 311 TYPES

IDENTIFICATION AND DESCRIPTION

1.00 GENERAL

- 1.01 This section covers the identification and description of 1A1 and 6A (selector only) key service unit packages.
- 1.02 Key service units are complete packages made up of individual panel-type key telephone units, mounted and factory-wired on various apparatus mountings.
- 1.03 These key service units may be obtained with or without:
 - 66-type connecting blocks
 - Rectifier-transformer power plant
 - Dial selective intercommunicating
- 1.04 The 300 series key service units provide the basic requirements for 1A1 and 6A (selector only) key telephone systems. They consist of various combinations of 202D, 230B, 232B, 238A, 207C, and 216A key telephone units. They may be obtained as a complete unit when ordered by the appropriate code number.
- 1.05 The KS-15900, List 1 electromechanical interrupter is furnished with each key service unit and is plugged into either the 232B or the 238A key telephone unit, as appropriate.
- 1.06 Basic coding information, supplemented by additional numbers and letters added to the code (number 3), designates different arrangements of the 300-type key service units. For example, 301A3D identifies a specific packaged unit, as follows:

CODE

- First character (digit)—indicates assembly uses wire spring relay line circuit key telephone units interwired with other components.
- 3—only number used.
 - Second character (digit)—indicates type apparatus mounting:
- 0 —indicates 31B apparatus mounting.
 - 1—would indicate 16C apparatus mounting.
 - Third character (digit)—indicates type of cable-terminating facilities:
 - 0—would indicate screw terminals only on rear of interwired key telephone units.
- 1 1—indicates 66-type connecting blocks.
 - 2—would indicate A75A connector cable stub plus 66-type connecting blocks.
 - Fourth character (letter)—indicates version of key service unit in manufacture:
- A —indicates first version of package.
 - B—would indicate second version of package.
 - Fifth (and Sixth) character(s) (digit) indicates circuit- and service-feature combinations of packages:
- 3 See Tables A and B.
 - Last letter—when used, indicates dial selective intercommunicating circuit.
- **D**—only letter used.

- 1.07 Aluminum foil pressure-sensitive tapes, preprinted with the feature layout, are supplied on all 66-type connecting blocks associated with key service units.
- 1.08 See sections entitled (1) Equipment Cabinets and Apparatus Mountings, Identification and (2) Equipment Cabinets and Apparatus Mountings, Installation for identification and installation procedures for the following:
 - 177A Backboard
 - 31B Apparatus Mounting
 - 16C Apparatus Mounting
 - ED-69462-01, Group 1 Cabinet Assembly (floor stand only)
 - ED-69462-01, Group 2 Cabinet Assembly (cover assembly only)
 - ED-69462-01, Group 3 Cabinet Assembly (wood base only)
- 1.09 See section entitled Connecting Blocks, 66

 - 66B1-25 Connecting Block
 - 66C4-25 Connecting Block

2.00 DESCRIPTION

- 2.01 This series of key service units provides for:
 - Pickup and hold on 4 to 13 central office or PBX lines with or without a 9- or 18-station dial selective intercommunicating circuit.

 Electromechanical interrupter, flashing and winking lamps, interrupted audible signal, manual intercommunicating, and timeout.

300- and 301-Type Key Service Units (4 to 6 Lines)

- 2.02 These key service units are 4 to 6 central office or PBX line units. They are factory mounted and interwired and are comprised of various combinations of the following:
 - 177A Backboard
 - 31B Apparatus Mounting
 - 232B KTU (with KS-15900, List 1 Interrupter)
 - 230B KTU
 - 202D KTU
 - 207C KTU
 - ED-69462-01, Group 1, 2, and 3 Cabinet Assembly
 - 66-Type Connecting Blocks
- 2.03 The 300-type key service units are not equipped with the 66-type connecting blocks.
- 2.04 The 66-type connecting blocks are mounted on the 177A backboard behind the gate of the 31B apparatus mounting. They are arranged as follows:
 - Block A includes the station leads and power connection terminations.
 - Block B includes the manual intercommunicating line, audible signal, dial selective intercommunicating line, and incoming central office or PBX line terminations.




Fig. 1 - 301A2D KSU, Cover Removed

- 2.05 These key service units can be mounted as follows:
 - 177A backboard with 31B apparatus mounting, wall mounted. It may or may not use 116A cover.
 - 177A backboard with 31B apparatus mounting, enclosed in an ED-69462-01 cabinet assembly, wall or floor mounted.
- 2.06 The 300-type key service units may be ordered by using the appropriate code (see Table A). Follow local ordering instructions.
- 2.07 Fig. 1 shows a 301A2D key service unit arranged for wall mounting.




Fig. 2 - 301A4D KSU, Cover Removed

- **2.08** Fig. 2 shows a 301A4D key service unit with 177A backboard and 66-type connecting blocks.

302-Type Key Service Unit

2.09 The 302-type packages are comprised of the 302A3D and 302A4D key service units.An ED-69462-01 cabinet assembly is supplied as part of the unit.

2.10 A length of A75A connector cable terminated on 66-type connecting blocks is furnished as part of the 302 packages. These are

terminated as follows:

- Four station lines—terminals 1 through 24, A Block.
- Dial intercom T, R, LG, and L—terminals 17 through 20, B Block.
- Common audible B1 and R1—terminals 5 and 6, B Block.
- See section entitled Key Service Units, 300, 301, and 302 Types, Connections and Maintenance for connection data.




Fig. 3 - 302A4D KSU, Cover Removed

- 2.11 Dial intercommunicating codes are not terminated to allow for local assignment. Miscellaneous circuits may also be connected as required.
- 2.12 The two 302-type key service units are designed for plug-ended concept. Telephone sets may be plugged in directly or extended by use of connector cables and/or adapters.
- 2.13 The two 302-type units are the same as their equivalent 301-type counterparts, with the exception of the A75A connector cable.
- 2.14 Fig. 3 shows a 302A4D key service unit in an open position. This shows the length of A75A cable.

310- and 311-Type Key Service Units (4 to 7 Lines)

2.15 The 310- and 311-type key service units, 4 to 7 central office or PBX line packages, are factory mounted on 16C apparatus mountings.

They are comprised of combinations of the following units:

- 232B KTU (with KS-15900, List 1 Interrupter)
- 230B KTU
- 202D KTU
- 207C KTU
- 2.16 The 311-type packages have three 66-type connecting blocks mounted on the backboard of the 16C apparatus mounting. These blocks are arranged as follows:

- Block A—includes terminations for the station key cable leads, manual intercom leads, and dial intercom leads.
- Block B—includes the audible signal leads associated with the dial intercom and the audible signal leads associated with the line circuits.
- Block C—is not supplied.
- Block D—includes the central office and/or PBX lines and the power connection terminations.

- 2.17 The 310- and 311-type key service units differ only in that the 310-type key service units are not equipped with 66-type connecting blocks.
- 2.18 These key service units are designed for wall mounting, but may be associated with the ED-95023-01 metal stand described in the section entitled Equipment Cabinets and Apparatus Mountings, Identification.




Fig. 4 - 311A8D KSU, Gate Closed

- **2.19** Fig. 4 shows the 311A8D key service unit with the gate closed.




Fig. 5-311A8D KSU, Gate Open

2.20 Fig. 5 shows the 311A8D key service unit with the 66-type connecting blocks.

310- and 311-Type Key Service Units (9 to 13 Lines)

2.21 The 310- and 311-type key service units, 9 to 13 central office or PBX line packages, are factory mounted on 16C apparatus mountings. They are comprised of combinations of the following units:

- 238A KTU (with KS-15900, List 1 interrupter)
- 230B KTU
- 207C KTU
- 216A KTU

2.22 The 311-type packages have four 66-type connecting blocks mounted on the backboard of the 16C apparatus mounting. These blocks are arranged as follows:

- Block A-includes station key cable lead terminations.
- Block B—includes station key cable leads, dial intercom line, and audible signal lead associated with dial intercom line terminations.
- Block C—includes audible signal leads associated with dial intercom, and audible signal leads associated with line circuit terminations.
- Block D—includes central office and/or incoming PBX lines and power connection terminations.
- 2.23 The 310- and 311-type key service units differ only in that the 310-type key service units are not equipped with 66-type connecting blocks.




Fig. 6 - 311A12D KSU, Gate Closed

- 2.24 Fig. 6 shows the 311A12D key service unit with the gate closed.




Fig. 7 - 311A12D KSU, Gate Open

- **2.25** Fig. 7 shows the 311A12D key service unit with the 66-type connecting blocks.
- 2.26 These units are designed for wall mounting, but may be associated with the ED-95023-01 metal stand.
- **2.27** Fig. 8 shows the arrangement of key telephone units used in the various 300 series key service units.
- 2.28 See section entitled Key Service Units, 310 and 311 Types, Connections and Maintenance for connection and maintenance data.

3.00 HANDLING OF 300-, 301-, 302-, 310-, AND 311-TYPE KEY SERVICE UNITS

Wire spring relays are used almost exclusively in the above named packages. These relays will not stand rough or unusual handling, espe-

cially without adequate packing protection. Therefore, the following rules should apply when transporting and handling package units:

- Follow directions printed on cartons.
- Do not drop cartons.
- Ship in suitable cartons, adequately packed.
