PROTECTION FOR TELEPHONE WORKMEN

ON QUEENSBOROUGH BRIDGE

GENERAL

- 1.01 This section covers the protection for telephone workmen on the Queensborough Bridge.
- 1.02 In order to provide adequate protection for telephone workmen whose work brings themonto the roadway of the Queensborough Bridge, the Police Department have extended their cooperation and will assign an officer any hour of the day or night to direct traffic at the location on the bridge at which our men are working.

2. PROCEDURE

2.01 In the future when chauffeurs are making deliveries to or pick-ups from the roadway of the bridge or when other forces are assigned to jobs which will involve the use of the bridge roadway, the Foreman responsible for supervising the work shall arrange to notify Traffic Precinct N by calling Volunteer 5-1250 giving the location at which the work is to be done and the time the work is to be started. The officer in charge will detail a uniformed police officer to meet the telephone workman at the given location and time. In the event that the police officer is not at the location at our starting time, telephone to the police station, using any telephone on the bridge and an officer will be immediately sent to the particular location.
