Stromberg – Carlson Number Card Removal Instructions

The following instructions will show how to remove the number card ring and number card from Stromberg-Carlson "C" and "D" Type dials equipped with polycarbonate fingerwheels.

The first picture shows the assembled fingerwheel. {The numeral ring is omitted for clarity}



FIGURE 1: Assembled SC Fingerwheel with number card ring And card/window



FIGURE 2: TO REMOVE NUMBER CARD RING:

- 1. Place tip of screwdriver blade under notch in number card ring. {as shown at left}
- 2. Gently pry and twist screwdriver in slot.
- 3. Card ring will pop up from center of fingerwheel.
- 4. Lift card ring off, exposing number card and clear window.

TO RE-INSTALL NUMBER CARD & RING:

- 1. Place number card on center of fingerwheel.
- 2. Place clear plastic card window over number card.
- 3. Place card ring over fingerwheel center with notch in ring facing right.
- 4. Press card ring into place using firm pressure on alternate sides until

ring settles into place on fingerwheel.

Below is a picture of the number card ring, showing the notch:



SC Polycarbonate Fingerwheel Number Card Retainer Ring (Chrome Finish)



Bell System type number cards will fit the SC number card ring as well as AE type Number card rings.

NOTE: Images of fingerwheel are "grayed" to permit view of fingerwheel and card retainer. The actual fingerwheel is clear in color.
