

# "I WANTA TALK TO MY DADDY... HE'S AWAY"



**O**F COURSE he does—and it's just as easy and natural for him to telephone as it is for the rest of the family.

Just as important too. Not only to him, but to dad and mother it's the quickest, handiest way to know that "all's well" at home—and out where dad is—far away.

Long Distance rates to most points are lowest after 7 P.M. and all day Sunday. Then 3-minute station-to-station calls cost 35c for about 90 miles; 50c for about 150 miles; \$1 for about 425 miles.

Long Distance costs little and means so much—*use it often.*

*P. S. for Mothers*—Maybe dad won't see this unless you show it to him. And you might mention how much you'd like an extension telephone, right beside your bed. It costs very little, saves many steps and gives a lot of reassurance. Ask your telephone business office.
