
## TELEPHONE SETS 303 TYPE CONNECTIONS

## 1. GENERAL

1.01 This section covers the connections for the 303 type telephone sets, intended for use in wiring plans and the 1A key telephone system employing separately mounted switching keys and cut-off keys. These sets may be used at key stations where it is necessary to connect the ringing bridge and talking circuit to different lines.

## 2. CONNECTIONS

2.01 The following are connections of the 303 type telephone sets and typical connections of keys that may be used with them.



Fig. 1-303A, B, C and D Telephone Sets-Connections


