 - Add KS-19945, Lists 7 and 8 Charge-a-Call signs
- Add KS-20064, Lists 9A, 10A, 11A, 12A, 13A, 14, 15, 16, 17, and 18 Charge-a-Call signs.

2. IDENTIFICATION

PA. KS-19945, Lists 7 and 8






Fig. 1-\$KS-19945, Lists 7 and 8 Signs

- 2.01 Two signs are available (Fig. 1):
- (a) KS-19945, List 7:
 - 17-3/8 by 2-5/8 inches, single-faced, white graphic on blue background
 - Change-a-Call logo on front side
 - Has pressure sensitive adhesive on back side
 - Intended to mount on KS-19945 small talk coinless telephone facilities.
 - (b) KS-19945, List 8:

Same as List 7 except has blue graphics on white background.

B. KS-20063 Signs, Plate, and Mounting Bracket

- 2.02 Four signs are available (Fig. 2 and 3).
 - (a) KS-20063, List 1:

12 inches square.

- 2.04 Four accessories are available.
 - (a) KS-20063, List 4 sign reinforcing plate (Fig. 24 and 26):

Used with List 3 sign when sign is pole mounted or mounted with List 5 brackets.

(b) KS-20063, List 5 sign mounting bracket (Fig. 26):

Used when either of the signs are mounted on a corner.

- (c) KS-20063, List 7 sign mounting bracket (Fig. 27):
 - Clear anodized aluminum
 - Intended for use with KS-20063, List 1, 2, or 3 sign on KS-20842 SENTRY* public telephone enclosure List 170 or 176 mast
 - Designed to accommodate either one or two phone signs.
- (d) KS-20063, List 8 sign mounting bracket (Fig. 27):

Same as the KS-20063, List 7 except the List 8 is black in color.

C. KS-20064 Signs

- 2.05 The KS-20064 signs are replacements for the KS-19027 signs which are rated MD.
- 2.06 Eighteen signs are available.




Fig. 4-KS-20064, List 1, 2, or 5 Sign

 - (a) KS-20064, List 1 (Fig. 4):
 - 7 inches square
 - · Vinyl decal lettered on one side
 - Intended for indoor or outdoor use
 - Has pressure sensitive adhesive on back for mounting to flat smooth surface

- Has white handset and word Phone on blue background.
- (b) KS-20064, List 2 (Fig. 4):
 - 7 inches square
 - Anodized aluminum sheet lettered on one side
 - · Intended for indoor or outdoor use
 - Has white handset and word Phone on blue background
 - · Has two holes for wall mounting
 - Hardware not furnished and must be ordered separately.




Fig. 5-KS-20064 Sign-Arrow Right




Fig. 6-KS-20064 Sign-Arrow Left

 - Hardware not furnished and must be ordered separately to suit mounting conditions.
 - (e) KS-20064, List 5 (Fig. 4):
 - 7 inches square
 - Square decal lettered on one side with white handset and word Phone on blue background
 - Has pressure sensitive adhesive on front for mounting to flat smooth surface
 - · Intended for indoor use
 - Translucent allowing signs to be backlighted.
 - (f) KS-20064, List 6 (Fig. 5 and 6):
 - Rectangular decal with white arrow on blue background on one side
 - Has pressure sensitive adhesive on front for mounting to flat smooth surface
 - · Intended for indoor use
 - Used with KS-20064, List 5 sign
 - Can be placed on either of the four sides of sign
 - · Translucent allowing sign to be back-lighted.
 - (g) KS-20064, List 7 (Fig. 7):
 - 7-inch square vinyl decal, single-faced, white graphics on blue background
 - · Has the wheelchair logo with the word Phone

- · Has pressure sensitive adhesive on back side
- Intended for indoor use.
- (h) KS-20064, List 8 (Fig. 8):
 - 7-inch square vinyl decal, single-faced, white graphics on blue background
 - Has the amplified handset logo with the word Amplify
 - Has pressure sensitive adhesive on back side
 - Intended for indoor use.

- (l) KS-20064, List 12A (Fig. 10):

Same as List 11A except has arrow right.

(m) KS-20064, List 13A:

- 5-3/8 inches square, single-faced, white handset, blue background, and white graphics
- Lexan material
- · Charge-a-Call logo on front side
- · Has pressure sensitive adhesive on back side
- Intended for wall mounting above a coinless public telephone set.
- (n) KS-20064, List 14:

Same as List 9A except has blue graphics on white background.

(o) KS-20064, List 15:

Same as List 10A except has blue graphics on white background.

(p) KS-20064, List 16 (Fig. 11):

Same as List 11A except has blue graphics on white background.

(q) KS-20064, List 17:

Same as List 12A except has blue graphics on white background.

(r) KS-20064, List 18 (Fig. 12):

Same as List 13A except has blue graphics on white background.




Fig. 9-\$KS-20064, List 9A or 10A Sign \$




Fig. 10-\$KS-20064, List 12A Sign\$




Fig. 11-\$KS-20064, List 16 Sign\$




Fig. 12-\$KS-20064, List 18 Sign\$

- D. Walk-up, Drive-up Signs
- 2.08 Two signs are available.




Fig. 13-KS-20065, List 6 Sign

 - (a) KS-20065, List 6 (Fig. 13):

Intended for use at walk-up installations or in the vicinity of a coin station.




Fig. 14-KS-20065, List 5 Sign

(b) KS-20065, List 5 (Fig. 14):

Intended for use at drive-up installations.

- 2.09 These signs have the following features:
 - · Consist of aluminum sheet
 - Have white, reflective letters and handset symbol on blue background (List 5 has arrow also)
 - Lettered on one side only
 - For indoor or outdoor use

- Designed to mount on one:
 KS-20065, List 7 post (9 feet long)
 KS-20065, List 8 post (11 feet long)

E. Advance Warning Signs

- 2.10 Four signs are available:
 - KS-20065, List 1 (Fig. 15)
 - KS-20065, List 2 (Fig. 16)
 - KS-20065, List 3 (Fig. 17)
 - KS-20065, List 4 (Fig. 18).
- 2.11 These signs have the following features:
 - · Are intended for use along highways
 - · Consist of aluminum sheet
 - Have white reflective letters and handset symbol on blue background (Lists 3 and 4 have arrows)
 - · Are lettered on one side only
 - Were designed to mount on two KS-20065, List 7 posts (9 feet long) or two KS-20065, List 8 posts (11 feet long)
 - Mounting hardware furnished with sign(s).

F. KS-20125 Signs and Mounting Bracket

- 2.12 Two signs and one bracket are available.




Fig. 19-KS-20125, List 1 Sign

 - (a) KS-20125, List 1 sign (Fig. 19):
 - Anodized aluminum sheet
 - Has word Phone in white letters on blue background on both sides
 - · Knockouts are provided for mounting
 - · For indoor or outdoor use




Fig. 20—KS-20125, List 2 Sign and KS-20125, List 3 Sign Bracket

- (c) KS-20125, List 3 mounting bracket (Fig. 20):
 - Mounts either the List 1 or 2 signs to a vertical surface
 - Bracket not furnished and must be ordered separately
 - Fasteners for securing sign to bracket are furnished with bracket but mounting hardware must be ordered separately to suit mounting conditions.

 - · Made of reflective scotchlite material
 - · Adhesive backed
 - Intended for indoor or outdoor use; primarily for the KS-20842, List 31 coin telephone housing (Fig. 22).

3. INSTALLATION

- ♦A. KS-19945 Signs
- 3.01 These signs are adhesive backed. To install peel off the paper backing and stick on.

B. KS-20063 Signs

- 3.02 These signs can be mounted at right angle to.
 - (a) A flat surface (Fig. 23):

Use hardware per Table A to suit mounting conditions.

(b) Metal pole (Fig. 24):

Use No. 170- or 188-type brackets

Refer to Fig. 24, 25 and Table B for complete description of brackets.

(c) A corner (Fig. 26):




Fig. 21—KS-21823, List 1 Sign




Fig. 22—KS-20842, List 31 Housing With KS-21823, List 2 Sign Installed

Use hardware per Table A to suit mounting conditions.



KS-20063, List 3 signs, pole mounted or corner mounted, require a KS-20063, List 4 reinforcing plate to prevent buckling (Fig. 24 and 25.)




Fig. 23—KS-20063 Sign, Wall-Mounted

(d) List 170 or 176 mast (Fig. 27):

Use KS-20063, List 7 or 8 mounting bracket

Use hardware per Table A to suit mounting conditions.

C. KS-20064 Signs

- 3.03 The KS-20064 signs are designed for mounting to flat surfaces.
- 3.04 The Lists 1, 3, 7, 8, ▶9A, 10A, 11A, 12A, 13A, 14, 15, 16, 17, and 18♠ signs have pressure-sensitive adhesive on back for mounting. The Lists 5

and 6 signs have pressure-sensitive adhesive on front for mounting, use following procedure.

- (1) Ensure that surface is smooth, clean, and dry.
- (2) Remove paper protective backing.
- (3) Press sign firmly in position against surface.
- 3.05 The Lists 2 and 4 signs are equipped with holes for mounting. Mount with appropriate fastener per Table A.

D. KS-20065 Signs

Walk-up, Drive-up Signs

3.06 The KS-20065, Lists 5 and 6 signs have two mounting holes each. They may be mounted on a KS-20065, List 7 or 8 post or they may be mounted on a flat surface.

Note: Driving caps are available, but not furnished, for driving the post into the ground.

- 3.07 The following hardware is furnished with each sign:
 - Two 5/16-18 by 2 round head aluminum bolts
 - Two 5/8 outside diameter, 11/32 inside diameter by 1/16 thick laminated paper washer
 - Two 5/16-inch lockwashers
 - Two 5/16-18 aluminum hex nuts.

Advance Warning Signs

- 3.08 The location for KS-20065 advance warning signs should conform with local highway regulations. Maximum visibility from the greatest distance should be provided for the approaching motorist.
- 3.09 For effects of proper and improper sign installations, refer to Fig. 28.
- 3.10 When excessive glare from the face of the signs affects its legibility, turn sign slightly away from road as illustrated in Fig. 29.
- 3.11 The KS-20065 signs are equipped with mounting screws, nuts, and washers. Two KS-20065




Fig. 24—KS-20063, List 3 Sign, Pole Mounted

sign mounting posts are required for each advance warning sign. These posts are available in lengths of 9 or 11 feet. The required length of the mounting posts and the depth to which they shall be placed will vary with local soil conditions. The posts should be placed to a depth sufficient to hold sign rigidly at an angle which provides maximum visibility. This usually is at right angles to the traffic.



E. KS-20125 Signs

- 3.13 These signs may be mounted on flat surfaces or perpendicular to a wall (Fig. 19 or 20).
- 3.14 Remove appropriate knockouts for mounting.
- 3.15 Use hardware per Table A to suit mounting conditions.
- 3.16 Use KS-20125, List 3 mounting bracket (must be ordered separately) when installing perpendicular to a wall (Fig. 20).

F. KS-21823 Signs

3.17 These signs have pressure-sensitive adhesive on back for mounting. Use following procedure.

- (1) Ensure that surface is smooth, clean, and dry.
- (2) Remove paper protective backing.
- (3) Press sign firmly in position against mounting surface.




Fig. 26-KS-20063, List 3 Sign, Corner Mounted




Fig. 28—Selection of Location for KS-20065 Advance Warning Sign






Fig. 29—Locating Sign to Reduce Glare




Fig. 30-KS-20065, List 1 Installation
