TELEPHONE MAINTENANCE RADIO SERVICE

1. GENERAL

- 1.001 This Addendum supplements Section 400-330-002 for Telephone Maintenance Radio Service and Business Radio Service provided by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company.
- 1.002 This Addendum is issued to provide guidelines for posting and operating requirements at control points* dispatch points and base stations.

5. OPERATING REQUIREMENTS

Control Point

(Change the following paragraph)

- 5.13 Each station in these services must be provided with one or more control points, unless permitted to be operated on an unattended basis or by mobile control. (See the FCC Rules for unattended operation.) The locations of the control points are specified on the license. If there is more than one control point, the principal control point shall be the first control point designated on FCC Form 400.

(Change the following paragraph)

- 5.15 The original station authorization or certified copy will normally be posted at the control point or as otherwise provided in the FCC Rules. The person responsible for the proper operation of the station shall insure that the license is properly posted and the following information is maintained.

- (a) A current list of all users (mobiles and pagers) shall be on file or posted at each control point. The list be signed and dated by the section's Network Maintenance radio coordinator.
- (b) A current list of all dispatch points associated with each base station shall be on file or posted at each control point. If there is more than one control point per system, the principal control point shall have the supervision control of all dispatch points.
- (c) A current list of control operators shall be on file or posted at each control point.

Dispatch Points

(Change the following paragraph)

- 5.31 Stations in these services are not limited as to the number of dispatch points. They may be added, relocated or discontinued at the option of the licensee. Companies are cautioned, however, that in order for system management to be more effective and its use more efficient, the number of dispatch points should be kept to a minimum. Operation of the transmitter from dispatch points is permitted only when the control operator at a fixed control point in

the system is on duty and at no other time.

9. STATION RECORDS

Logs

9.07 Each station in these services is required to keep a technical log.

The technical log shall be maintained at the transmitter location.

Employees even remotely connected with the station must know exactly
where the technical log is kept.
