1. GENERAL

1.01 This section is issued to furnish information to aid in the identification of the 5302-, 5304-, 5306-, and 5410-type telephone sets.

2. IDENTIFICATION

2.01 The 5300 and 5400 series consists of the 300-series and single-button 400-series telephone sets converted to

approach the appearance and performance of the 500-series sets. This is obtained by the use of a new housing, new dial ring, new number plate, and a ringer volume adjustment which may be controlled by the subscriber.

2.02 The numbering scheme for the 5300 and 5400 series was derived by preceding by the digit 5 the number of the set in the 300 or 400 series from which it was converted. As an example, the 302-G-3 set converted would become the 5302-G-3 set.

Note: F- or G-type handsets may be used with either set.
