TELEPHONE SETS 554, 556, AND 558 TYPES CONNECTIONS

1. GENERAL

1.01 This section covers the connections for the following telephone sets:

Manual	<u>Dial</u>
554A or AR	554B or BR
556A or AR	556B or BR
558A or AR	558B or BR

- 1.02 Cords and conductors within the set should be fastened and so arranged to avoid interference with moving parts.
 - 1.03 Tables, which show the connections for all classes of service which can be provided by these sets, are included.
- 1.04 Line connections within the 554- and 556-type sets are made on the network. Line connections within the 558-type set are made on the terminal strip under the dial, or on the network, or on both.
- 1.05 For manual service, replace the dial with a 95B apparatus blank and transfer the slate-white switch lead to the RR terminal on the network.
- 1.06 Table B shows tube and ringer connections for areas where no inductive interference is encountered. For locations of average or severe induction (see Section C63.271, Line and Ringer Connections, Use of Vacuum Tubes to Reduce Induction and to Provide Additional Ringing Bridges), use connections shown in Table C or D.




Fig. 1-554A (Manual) and 554B (Dial) Telephone Sets




Fig. 2-556A (Manual) and 556B (Dial) Telephone Sets




Fig. 3-558A (Manual) and 558B (Dial) Telephone Sets
