STATION CORDS **ALL TYPES**

1. GENERAL

- This section covers general information pertaining to all types of station cords. It is reissued to include colored plastic retractile and extra length colored cords. Cords for all 400- and 500-type key telephone sets are also included. Marginal arrows have been omitted, due to extensive changes.
- A neoprene jacket and rubber insulated conductors are generally used on black cords having six or less conductors. The conductor insulation is of a solid color such as red, yellow, etc. Conductors having four small ridges moulded in the rubber are called double colored conductors, such as red-red or yellow-yellow.
- A vinyl plastic jacket and plastic insulated conductors are generally used on cords of six or more conductors, and on colored cords. The conductor insulation is either a solid color or striped.
- 1.04 A cotton fabric jacket is used on some cords. Cords of this type with ten or less conductors generally have rubber conductor insulation. This group includes the colored fabric cords for the 200- and 300-type telephone sets. Cottoncovered cords for key telephone sets, with over ten conductors, have conductors insulated with colored yarn covered with transparent plastic.
- Cotton-covered cords may be used as furnished with equipment unless the extra moisture resistance or durability of the waterproof-jacketed cords is desired.

2. CODE NUMBERS

- 2.01. The characters in the code numbers for cords, such as D3BB-3 have the following significance:
 - (a) The first character designates the principle use as follows:
 - D-Telephone Set Mounting Cord

 - H—Handset Cord L—Operator's Telephone Set Cord
 - M-Miscellaneous Cord
 - R -Receiver Cord
 - T-Transmitter Cord

W-Test Cord

- (b) The second character corresponds to the number of conductors in the cord.
- (c) The third character unit which may consist of one or two letters having no special significance, is assigned to indicate physical structure of the cord.
- (d) The dash number indicates the color as follows:

3. LENGTH OF CORDS

- 3.01 Telephone set mounting cords have a standard length of approximately 5-1/2 feet. Some mounting cords are also available in 9-, 13-, and 25-foot lengths. The 25-foot cords should be used only for special cases. Cords for multikey telephone sets are of the 5-1/2-foot length only.
- 3.02 Handset cords, for all except special services, are of a standard 4-foot length, but some may be obtained in a 9-foot length. Cords for special services, such as outdoor sets, elevator sets, etc., may vary from a 1- to a 4-foot length.
- Cords, especially those longer than standard length, should not be installed where they would create a hazard such as across doorways, stairs, or passageways, or where they will be subject to excessive wear.

4. RETRACTILE CORDS

4.01 Helically wound retractile handset and mounting cords are made so they may be stretcheed about four times their retracted length. A desk-type telephone set having a retractile cord may be equipped with KS-8035 friction pads to prevent the set from slipping when the cord is extended.
