# **IDENTIFICATION AND ASSEMBLY OF PARTS**



### 1.00 INTRODUCTION




Fig. 2-701B Telephone Set with Housing Removed

This section covers the 701B telephone set (see Fig. 1, 2, and 3). This set is referred to as the Princess telephone.

### 2.00 GENERAL

2.01 This common battery desk-type telephone set is equipped with a lamp that is used to

illuminate the dial and act as a night light by the flick of a switch.

- 2.02 The set is furnished wired for individual and 2-party flat-rate service. The following changes are made for other services:
  - Tip-party, message rate, flat rate with automatic ticketing, zone registration, and automatic message accounting (a cord conductor is moved to a different terminal).
  - 4-party selective and 8-party semiselective service require a cold cathode tube.




Fig. 3-701B Telephone Set with Dial and Lamp Socket Removed

#### 3.00 DESCRIPTION

**3.01** Description of the telephone set components (handset, dial, and network) may be found in the C Section pertaining to these items.

3.02 The 701B telephone set employs a transmission circuit similar to that of the 500 set.

- 3.03 Since an external ringer (E1A or F1A) is← required, the network does not contain a ringing capacitor. A light-weight spring cord is used with the standard G-type hand set.
- **3.04** The dial is similar to the 6-type dial except that the lamp located under the dial pro-

- r→ vides illumination. The translucent number plate is lighted indirectly through a light guide when the handset is removed or when the night-light switch is operated. Current for this lamp is fur-L, nished by the 2012A or KS-16184 transformer.
  - Slide switch on rear base of set provides reduced illumination of dial to serve as night light.
- Lamp socket is easily removed through base without opening set for lamp replacement.
- ► 3.05 The new dome-type finger wheel, P-11E007, is used with the 8A dial. This finger wheel requires the use of the modified station number card as covered in the C Section entitled Station
