Meet James T. Wells. He's a successful lawyer with hundreds of very important clients. Sometimes he needs to consult his files or look up a statute while speaking on the telephone. That's why he has chosen the 20-Button Handsfree Telephone.

The Handsfree model comes with a built-in microphone and speaker . . . plus all the other benefits of a Multi-Key Telephone.

When a ring and a flashing light tell lawyer Wells that he has an incoming call on one of his 17 lines, he pushes the flashing button and the yellow ON button. He is now ready to talk handsfree, without even lifting the receiver. He can even go across the room, up to twenty feet away, and still be heard.

He can temporarily leave his client's call without disconnecting it by pushing the red HOLD button. This leaves him free to place or receive other calls without being overheard. The signal lamp will keep flashing until he returns.

If background noise becomes distracting, the handset can be used as with a regular telephone. Once he lifts the handset, the handsfree portion is automatically cut off. It is reinstated when the handset is replaced in the cradle. To disconnect, he pushes the yellow OFF button. It's that easy from start to finish.

Models. There are three Handsfree models, depending on the busyness of your office.

20 Button: 17 line pick-up buttons, one for HOLD, and two for Handsfree ON and OFF.

10 Button: 7 line pick-up buttons, one for HOLD, and two for Handsfree ON and OFF.

Single Line: One line pick-up button, and two for Handsfree ON and OFF.

Colors. You have your choice of six different phone and ten different faceplate colors. You may agree with these first six color matches we have suggested. Or you may decide to create different color combinations, using any of the ten faceplate colors.
