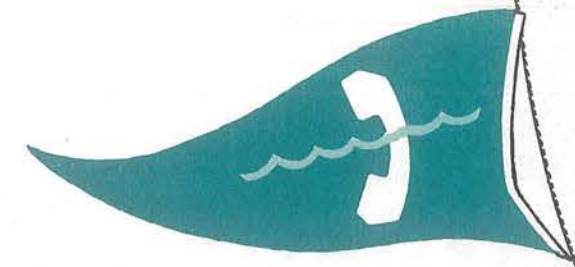


## HOW SLIP-TO-SHORE WORKS

- ▶ Dial telephones are stowed in waterproof boxes at dockside ready for use.
- ▶ When a yacht ties up, the telephone is removed from the box and placed aboard.
- ▶ When a yacht leaves the slip, the phone is secured in the box to protect it from the elements.
- ▶ If a message is received for a skipper who is away from the slip, a red light on the phone flashes until he returns and picks up the phone.

## WHY SKIPPERS WILL WANT SLIP-TO-SHORE

- ▶ Permits calls to be made in comfort and privacy in fair or foul weather.
- ▶ Makes it easy to keep in touch with home or office quickly and easily because all calls can be dialed directly.
- ▶ Eliminates the chance of missing important messages while away from the slip.
- ▶ Allows calls to be made directly to other boats in the marina.
- ▶ Provides instant contact with marina services with one spin of the dial.
