Com Key 416 options include:

- **Power Failure Transfer.** Your lines continue to ring even if outside power fails; your ability to make outgoing calls remains unaffected.
- **Privacy/Privacy Release.** No one can enter or listen in on your call – until you permit it by depressing the Privacy Release Button.
- **Music-On-Hold.** Entertaining way to let callers know they're not forgotten.
- **Station Restriction.** Lets you limit number of telephones that can place outside calls – without limiting incoming or intercom calls.
- **Preset Intercom Voice Signaling.** One prearranged button allows you to signal or broadcast to any preselected combination of stations.
- **Hands-Free Answering on Intercom Stations.** Selected intercom telephones can be used for voice response without having to lift receiver.
- **Built-in Speakerphone Service.** Permits "hands free" conversations on all central office lines.
- **Paging Loudspeakers.** Page via telephone and broadcast background music from your own music source – with individual volume adjustment for both uses.
- **Access to Supplementary Ringing.** Noisy locations? Signal incoming calls with external ringer or loud bell.
