

how it works . . .

- 1. IN AN EMERGENCY, any person can immediately call for help from the nearest telephone call box, using the familiar telephone handset and giving a voice report.
- 2. AT THE CONTROL CENTER, your dispatcher gets all the needed facts quickly. As soon as the handset is lifted, a printed record of the time, date and call-box number is automatically made.
- 3. WHEN A FIRE IS REPORTED, the dispatcher calls the needed company or companies, gives them the facts, and directs them to the exact location with the necessary equipment.
- 4. WHEN A POLICE MATTER IS REPORTED, the call is immediately routed to your police dispatcher, who summons squad car, ambulance or whatever emergency units are required.











Each telephone box can be equipped with a pushbutton mounted just above the handset. By depressing this special button, policemen can bypass control center and be connected directly to police headquarters.
