Handset cords are furnished in the same color as the handset and can be arranged to enter the housing from left side or left front. Five face mats will be shipped with each set. The colors are dull silver, dull gold, pale blue, pale green and cream white.

Up to 30 buttons on one telephone to provide multi-line pickup, call holding, intercom, plus add-on, selective conference arrangements and pushbutton signalling such as that available with the 6A key system.

Any new customer who requires more service than can be accommodated using six button key telephones. These are situations where in the past we would have served the customer with six button telephones and separate pads or pushbuttons, or with 101 type key cabinets, or perhaps a small switchboard.

Existing customers who have outgrown the service capacity of six button key telephones. Among these, are customers who need additional C.O. or P.B.X. lines, a 6A dial intercom system, add-on, pushbutton station selection and signalling.

Existing customers with 101 key cabinets who are moving or planning major service rearrangements.

Existing customers whose 101 key cabinet or cabinets are at capacity and whose service requirements have increased.

1. FOR CONNECTION OF:

- (a) Central office or PBX extension lines which are equipped with holding and combined flashing line and steady busy lamps.
- (b) Intercommunication lines which are equipped with steady busy or combined lamps or private lines which are equipped with combined lamps.
- (c) Central office or PBX extension lines which are equipped with holding and combined flashing line, steady busy and winking hold lamps.

The above charges are basic and apply to each call director set installed. The charges include the use of the buttons in the set for pickup, hold and signaling and the associated lamps.



6A KEY TELEPHONE SYSTEM

The 6A key telephone packages provide a number of new features not available in the present nine station dial intercommunicating system that is now part of many 1A and 1A1 systems.

The popularity of the nine station dial intercom system exceeded all expectations, but in many instances, it was found inadequate in meeting all of a customer's requirements. The 6A system, in addition to providing various new service options, is designed to meet the immediate need for a system of larger capacity. It has a practical maximum of 36 station codes and two talking paths. Such features as privacy, flashing lamps, preset and add-on conference, busy tone, station common audible signal and camp-on make the 6A a most versatile package.

FOR THE CUSTOMER ...

THE TWO LINK system can carry up to eight times the intercom traffic that could be handled with the Single Link system.

FLEXIBILITY has been built in — P.B.X. or central office calls can be transferred to or conferenced with another 6A station even though the line does not appear at that station. Two add-on features are standard with Single and Two Link systems—additional add-on arrangements are available as optional features.

MINIMUM EQUIPMENT REQUIRED — takes up little valuable desk space since the station termination can be in any standard or key type telephone.

CONVENIENCE is added and valuable time saved for those persons who find it necessary to arrange interoffice conferences. Two preset conference arrangements are standard with Single and Two Link systems and additional preset conference features are available at nominal cost. For those persons who may prefer pushbutton selection over dialing, pushbutton selection of stations for simple, fast and convenient operation is now available.

COMPLETE PRIVACY now offered with this system assures the security of confidential calls and prevents accidental intrusions.

A PAY AS YOU USE PLAN — no capital investment necessary — no installation or maintenance worries.

PRIORITY OF ACCESS to a busy station or system is provided with "camp-on" feature. Where desired, off-premises locations can be included on the system.

As a moderately priced intercom system with good customer appeal, the 6A holds great promise of proving to be a valuable addition to the present line of service offerings.

Description and Operation

The 6A is a dial or pushbutton selective local intercom system available in three package plans, and with various optional features. It accommodates up to 36 station codes.

THE SELECTOR ONLY SYSTEM...

Type A is roughly equivalent to the present 9-station system but having the capacity to expand to 36 station codes. Busy lamps are standard with this system.

THE SINGLE LINK SYSTEM...

Type B has a single talking path with a 36 station capacity that is equipped for line and busy lamps. Automatic privacy, two preset conference arrangements and two add-on arrangements are standard. Optional features include camp-on, pushbutton selection, additional preset and add-on conference arrangements.

THE TWO LINK SYSTEM...

Type C has two talking paths plus all the standard features of the One Link System and the busy tone and camp-on feature. Optional features include pushbutton selection and additional preset conference and addon arrangements.

TALKING ARRANGEMENTS...

With Single Link System—station codes are dialed on selector circuit and automatically transferred to the line circuit for talking.

With Two Link System — calls are initially established on the primary link and after the called station answers, immediately transferred *automatically* to the second link. If the second link is already in use, the call remains on the primary link until the second link is free at which time the call is automatically transferred to the second link. After the transfer is completed the system is ready for another call on the primary link.

NOTE: The automatic transfer can be heard as a momentary click by parties being transferred.

AUTOMATIC PRIVACY...

Equipped with this feature called and calling stations will exclude other 6A stations provided the called station answers before another station comes in on the system.

CAMP-ON...

Allows a station, after picking up and finding a busy condition, to wait and reserve (camp-on) until the called station is free to answer or the system is free to receive another call. The previously selected station is then *automatically* signalled.

NOTE: Camp-on does not operate when using pushbutton selection.

PRESET CONFERENCE ...

Enables a station to select a fixed group of stations by means of a dialed code or pushbutton. A maximum of six station codes may be prewired to a control circuit. All conference stations are signalled whenever the preset conference code is selected.

NOTE: Two preset conference arrangements are standard with Single and Two Link systems.

SELECTIVE CONFERENCE...

Available in any arrangement where pushbutton signalling has been provided. Selection is made by operating pushbuttons simultaneously or individually in rapid succession. All selections must be made before any of the selected stations answer.

ADD-ON...

Allows interconnection of a previously held C.O. or P.B.X. line with any 6A station. With this feature a key telephone can, after placing the incoming call on hold, depress the add-on button and establish a three way conversation.

An additional advantage of this feature is the ability to connect a *keyless* station associated with the intercom system to outside station lines under the control of a station equipped for add-on conferencing.

NOTE: A separate button is required for each line equipped for add-on.
