#### STATION CORDS

301.1 GENERAL: This practice contains general information pertaining to standard types of station cords.

301.1-a Station cord conductors are insulated with rubber or plastic covering. The rubber insulation is normally used on cords having ten or less conductors. This rubber conductor covering is of a solid color such as red, green, blue, white, etc. Single colored conductors have a smooth surface. Conductors having four ridges molded in the surface of the rubber are considered double-colored conductors. The conductors of cords with more than ten conductors are generally insulated with a smooth transparent plastic insulation. Colored yarns underneath the plastic are used to identify the conductors.

301.2 CODING: So that cords may be more easily identified, manufacturers, in general, have assigned letter-number-letter or suffix letter codes which have the following significance.

301.2-a Whitney-Blake Cords. The prefix letter "T" indicates the supplier; the first number refers to the number of conductors; the next two digits denote the type of end preparations; the next letter designates the principal use, i.e., "D" (line cords) for desk set, also handset mounting and telephone set mounting, "H" for handset and "R" for receiver. The remaining digits refer to the jacketed length of cord in inches. The code make-up for retractile cords consists entirely of numbers and contains no letters. The length of the cord is determined by measuring the overall length including the tips.

301.2-b Western Electric Cords. The first character of the code, a letter, designates the principal use; "D" (line cords) for desk set, also handset mounting and telephone set mounting, "H" for handset and "R" for receiver. The second character of the code, a number, corresponds to the number of conductors. The third and fourth characters of the code, a letter or letters, have no special significance and are arbitrarily assigned to indicate variation in physical structure such as insulation, cord tips, etc. In some cases a dash number is used to designate the cord color. Length of cords is determined by the distance measured between the cord ties, or clips.
