### TELEPHONE SERVICE INFORMATION

1. General: The Atlantic and Pacific area military telephone system is completely dial. All telephone numbers consist of four digits, prefixed by the telephone exchange identification number. Telephone exchange identification numbers are as follows:

- 82 - Fort Amador and Quarry Heights
- 83 - Curundu and Albrook Industrial Area
- 84 - Fort Kobbe
- 85 - Post of Corozal
- 86 - Albrook Air Force Base
- 87 - Fort Clayton
- 8 - Fort Davis and Fort Gulick
- 8 - Fort Sherman

A Dial Chart appears on the inside front cover.

Panama City - Automatic Exchange : Dial 928 or 829, listen for new dial tone, then dial desired number as listed in the Panama City Telephone Directory.

Colon - Manual Exchange: Dial 938, then give the answering operator the desired number.

## TELEPHONE SERVICE INFORMATION - Cont'd

### 2. Application for Telephone Service

- a. Official requests for new installations, relocations, reassignments, disconnects, etc., will be made in writing to the Post Signal Officer, Corozal on the Pacific Side, and Fort Davis on the Atlantic Side. All requests will include the following information:

- (1) Building number, room number (if applicable) and exact location of desired telephone.
- (2) Exact telephone directory listing desired.
- (3) Justification of work requested.
- (4) Approval of commanding officer or section chief concerned.

- b. Requests for unofficial (Class B) telephone service may be made by appearing in person at the Post Signal Office, Bldg 732, Corozal, or by calling 85-4247. On the Atlantic Side call at the Fort Davis Signal Office (8-7210).

3. Payment of Telephone Bills: All telephone bills are payable during the period of the 5th through the 15th of each month, at any of the following collection points:

After the 15th of each month, payment may be made only at the Post Signal Office, Building 732, Corozal, or the Telephone Exchange, Fort Davis, Canal Zone.

4. Charges for Class B Telephone Service: All Class B telephone subscribers are billed for service according to the calendar month, or portions thereof. This service is subdivided as follows:

TELEPHONE SERVICE INFORMATION - Cont'd

5. Standards of Service:

- a. Unsatisfactory Telephone Service should be reported to the Post Signal Officer, 85-2210 for Pacific Area, and 8-7210 for the Atlantic Area.
- b. Operators will not be requested to perform clerical duties.

6. Responsibilities of the Subscriber:

- a. Telephones installed in quarters or offices are the responsibility of the individual concerned, with respect of proper care and use.
- b. All work incident to the installing, relocating or disconnecting telephone equipment will be performed only by authorized Signal Corps personnel.
- c. The painting of telephone instruments is not authorized.
- d. Field Telephones and/or other attachments will not be connected to the telephone system.
