2. Application for Telephone Service

- a. Official requests for new installations, relocations, reassignments, discomments, etc., will be made in writing to the Post Signal Officer, Corozal on the Pacific Side, and Fort Davis on the Atlantic Side.
 All requests will include the following information:
 - (1) Building number, room number (if applicable) and exact location of desired telephone.
 - (2) Exact telephone directory listing desired.
 - (3) Justification of work requested.
 - (4) Approval of commanding officer or section chief concerned.
- b. Requests for unofficial (Class B) telephone service may be made by appearing in person at the Fost Signal Office, Bldg 732, Corozal, or by calling 85-4247. On the Atlantic Side call at the Fort Davis Signal Office (8-7210).
- 3. Fayment of Telephone Bills: All telephone bills are payable during the period of the 5th through the 15th of each month, at any of the following collection points:
