D/K 500 Series Telephones

Published in a horizontal format 11 inches wide and 5½ inches high, and lithographed on 60# uncoated paper in three colors. A black 60# half cover was not scanned. Found in a bookstore in Lancaster CA in 2004. The publishing date of 1956 is derived from the form number 5603 on the back cover. The type of phones illustrated are the D/K-500 series produced in the mid 50's in between the 1000 "Redbar" and the WE look-alike K-500 with slightly different styled case. The handset pictured on the K-500 set is a modified WE G3 style handset with rounded corners produced just before Kellogg began manufacturing the WE G3 look-alike in 1957. Also of note is the Kellogg/ITT logo which was used only for a few years before ITT dropped the Kellogg name.

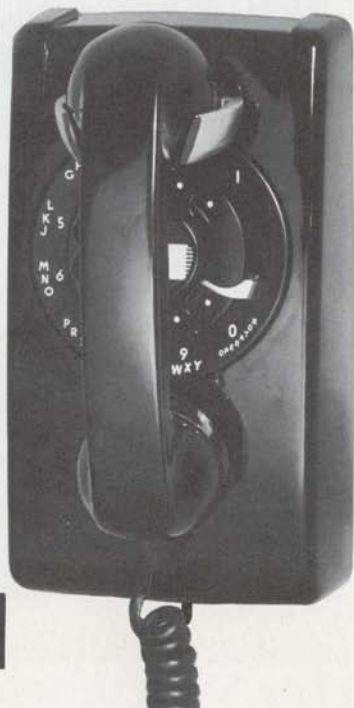
